PREPARATORY ACTIVITIES

Campus Pre-Placement Module (CPPM)

Every year the students opting for placements face some of the world's best employers in a competitive selection process. Designed especially to prepare them for the placement process is the Campus Placement Preparation Module (CPPM). It is a two-week training program which prepares students for the transition between an academic and a professional environment. The training program is conducted on campus, with CDC staff, faculty, and guests from various industries sharing their insights and knowledge with the students.

The CPPM has sessions which cover the most basic to the most complex part of the job application process. Starting with the creation of a resume and cover letter, to multiple practices of mock interviews and group discussions, technical interviews and multiple aptitude tests, each activity helps them understand what an actual interview day may look like. This is accompanied by soft skill workshops which teach students the importance of how body language, leadership, etiquette and grooming contribute to their overall evolution from students to professionals. CPPM is organized in association with industry leaders, subject matter experts & trainers, besides actively engaging our alumni in these sessions.

Please go through the Eligibility Criteria and Student Information given by Cognizant for their recruitment drive happening at SNU Campus on 2nd and 3rd September . In addition Rahul Ishwar will be sending a google form which requires certain data to be filled by you by 2 pm today .

Important:

- Students who are borderline CGPA of less than 6 may appear for the process as long as they can ensure they are 6 CGPA and above on the day of the joining if they get selected which will be from July 2017 onwards .
- The joining condition is 6 CGPA and above thus students who are currently eligible but fall below 6 CGPA at the end of 8th Semester will not be allowed to join the company even if selected .
- The students who are currently having backlogs are not eligible for this process .
